Whereas since morning today i.e. 9th July 2023, District Gurugram has experienced heavy & continuous rainfall and there is a prediction for heavy rainfall tomorrow as well. Whereas the civic authorities are actively working to address the situation, it is essential to exercise caution and minimize travel during such conditions as waterlogging can disrupt the smooth flow of traffic and pose risks to public safety.

Whereas the Directorate, School Education, Govt. of Haryana has asked undersigned to assess the prevailing situation in view of the heavy rains in Gurugram and take necessary measures for safety and security of the students vide their office letter No. Spl/1/ACD, dated 09.07.2023.

Therefore, in consideration of the aforementioned facts, **all Government and Private Schools (including Play schools etc.) falling in Gurugram district are hereby directed to remain closed tomorrow i.e. on 10th July 2023** in larger public interest and for safety & security of the students.
